All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different Funeral Directors (because prices can vary).



Attended Funeral (Funeral Director's charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same burial or cremation.	£1,898

Fees You Must Pay	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a Removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge other fees.	£150 - £900
